**Approval of Minutes:**

Minutes from April, 2017 were approved.

**CLE Co-Sponsorship Presentation (Christine Constantino/Danielle Edwards):**

Discussions about CLE co-sponsorship started in 2014 as a way to build a comprehensive CLE library for Oregon-licensed attorneys who are not located in metro areas. BOG voted in 2016 to allow OSB to have a right of first refusal to co-sponsor section CLEs 4 hours or longer. November 2016 HOD meeting set up special committee to review the proposal and comments. BOG will vote at June meeting following comment submission, and comments should be submitted by mid-June. All-day OSB sponsored CLEs usually cost attendees \$200, so the proposal would likely double the ENR Section's annual CLE attendance cost. The OSB will bear the financial burden for any loss on a co-sponsored CLE. The current proposal is a right of first refusal to co-sponsor every third year.

Dustin commented that OSB needs to articulate clear standards and timelines if the program will go forward. Sections need to know how far in advance to inform the OSB of a CLE, and the OSB needs a deadline for response to sections about co-sponsorship.

Several members commented that it makes more sense for the OSB to simply require sections to record their CLEs, and the ENR section could easily budget recording into the CLE for less increase in cost than the OSB will require. We will lose attendance every third year when the cost of attendance will be double the normal cost.

Dustin will draft comments in opposition to the CLE co-sponsorship proposal and will circulate to the ENR executive committee for comments prior to submission.

**Chair's report (Dustin):**

Dustin received communications from several organizations asking for donations. The ENR Section decided several years ago not to make charitable contributions on behalf of the Section because interests vary widely across the section. The executive committee can revisit charitable contributions if anyone believes that is warranted.
