William K. “Billy” Barquin is the Attorney General of the Kootenai Tribe of Idaho and oversees all legal aspects of Tribal operations. His work concentrates on negotiated problem solving on behalf of the Tribe in a variety of contexts. That work includes ongoing representation of the Kootenai Tribal Fish and Wildlife Department regarding the interrelationships of the Northwest Power Act, Endangered Species Act, National Historic Preservation Act and other legal authorities in the protection of Kootenai natural resource utilization. Prior to joining the Kootenai Tribe staff, Billy represented tribal governments as a member of two separate firms. He is Eastern Shoshone and Oglala Lakota and was raised on his father’s ranch on the Wind River Indian Reservation in Wyoming. He earned his bachelor and law degrees at Gonzaga University.
